Pierce County joined the UW Valleys Diaper Bank network in February 2023 through a partnership with the Pierce County Food Pantry in Ellsworth. Since then, the program has helped expand access to essential diaper resources for children and families throughout the county.

Community support has been key to the program's continued growth. Led by the River Falls Rotary Club, the annual River Falls diaper drive brings together businesses, schools, organizations, and community members to provide thousands of diapers and wipes each year for local families.

Through ongoing collaboration with local organizations, volunteers, and distribution partners, the UW Valleys Diaper Bank remains committed to providing reliable diaper support and expanding access for families throughout Pierce County.

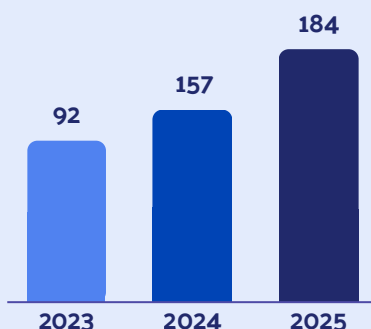
Community Partners

Community partnerships have been essential to the growth of the UW Valleys Diaper Bank in Pierce County. The Hunger Prevention Council (Pierce County Food Pantry) provides a trusted location for diaper distribution, while the River Falls Rotary Club organizes the annual River Falls Community Diaper Drive, coordinating collection sites that generated more than 58,000 diapers and 1,100 packs of wipes in 2025.
